







March 2011 BOM – Churn Dash - 9 ½” Block

Fabrics:		Cutting Instructions	Colours
Blue		One 2" x 14" strip	Medium to medium-dark blue
Blue		Two 3 7/8" squares	Medium-dark or dark blue
Yellow		One 2" x 14" strip Two 3 7/8" squares One 3 ½ " square	Light to Medium yellow in tone on tone or with small print that co-ordinates with the blue

Instructions:

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the two 3 7/8" yellow squares. Place each yellow square on a blue 3 7/8" square with right sides together and raw edges aligned. Sew a ¼" seam on each side of the diagonal line. Cut apart on the line and press seam allowances toward the darker fabric. Trim points and trim to measure 3 ½" square if needed. Make 4 pieced half-triangle units. 
- Place a blue 2" x 14" strip right sides together with a yellow 2" x 14" strip. Sew the two strips along one long edge using scant ¼" seams. Press seams towards the darker fabric. 
- Cut this strip into four units of 3 ½" long. Note that the resulting pieced units will be 3 ½" square. 
- To assemble Row 1:
 - Place a pieced half-triangle square on the left side of a pieced rectangle square, with right sides together, as shown. Sew using a scant ¼" seam
 - Place a pieced half-triangle square on the right side of this unit. Sew using a scant ¼" seam to create Row 1.
 - Press seams towards the centre.
- Repeat the above steps to form Row 3.
- To assemble Row 2
 - Place a pieced rectangle square on the left side of the centre square with right sides together. Sew using a scant ¼" seam.
 - Place the remaining pieced rectangle square on the right side of this unit and sew using a scant ¼" seam to form Row 2.
 - Press seams to the outside.
- Lining up seams, assemble the rows as shown and sew using a scant ¼" seam.
- Press seams.
- Trim to 9 ½" square
- Attach your name tag. Prepare a second name tag to use to enter your name in the draw. Preparing these at home reduces the congestion at the BOM table during the meeting and we appreciate your cooperation.
