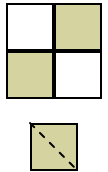
March 2010 BOM – Endless Possibilities – 8 ½” x 8 ½ “ unfinished

You will construct this block using 3 colours – a light, a medium and a dark. For the dark fabric please use a **blue**.

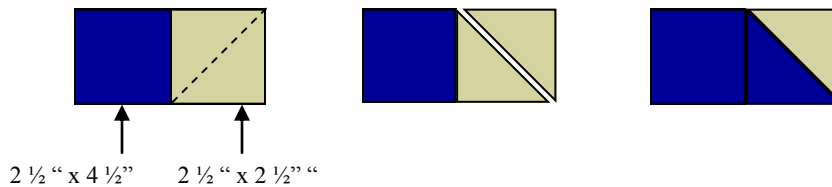
Fabrics:		Patch	Cutting Instructions	Colours
Light		A	Two 2 ½ “ squares	Any colour that you will use as your light colour.
Medium		B	Eight 2 ½ “ squares	Any colour that you will use as your medium colour.
Dark		C D E	Two 2 ½ “ squares Two 2 ½ “ x 4 ½ “ Two 2 ½ “ x 6 ½ “	Blue

Instructions:

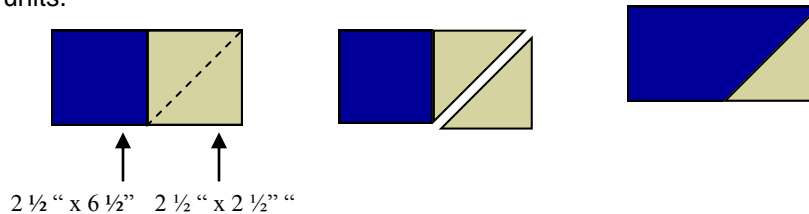
1. Make a 4-patch unit by sewing the two Light Patch A 2 ½ “ squares with two Medium Patch B 2 ½ “ squares, placing colours diagonally from each other.



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of four Medium Patch B 2 ½ “ squares. Place square on Dark Patch D 2 ½ “ x 4 ½ “ rectangle, right sides together, being careful of orientation, as shown below. Align the raw edges. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim leaving a ¼ “ seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Make 2 units.



3. Using the same technique used in Step 2 and using Medium Patch B 2 ½ “ squares and Dark Patch E 2 ½ “ x 6 ½ “ rectangles, being careful of orientation, as shown below. Make 2 units.



4. Sew a Medium Patch B 2 ½ “ square to the end of the unit made in step 3. Make 2 units.



5. Sew units made in Step 2 to the centre 4-patch unit, being careful of orientation.



6. Sew units made in Step 4 to top and bottom. Unfinished block size is 8 ½ “ x 8 ½ “.
