Guidelines

The 2022/2023 challenge for youth is to complete a quilt based on the **theme of Kindness**. Any style of quilting: art, traditional or modern is accepted. The quilt can be any **size up to a 200-inch perimeter**. It must be made of three layers and quilted, either by hand and/or machine. It must be either bound or closed along the edges with either hand or machine stitching. Most of the quilt must be the work of the young quilter. Most of the quilt should be made using quilters cotton. There are no specific fabrics that need to be used. The fabric chosen should be from the young quilter's ideas. The quilter may use any combination of hand-and /or machine-piecing, applique" and quilting. Embellishments such as beading, adding ribbon, paint, crayon, etc. may be used. Get creative! This is the time to experiment and try new skills.

The entry must be free from any text or images that are protected by copyright unless of course you have obtained permission from the source. For any patterns or designs that are not original, you must give credit to the source.

This challenge is open to any child sponsored by a ROYQG member. You do not have to be related. Hopefully you can guide your young quilter through the process and encourage them with your teachings. The idea is to get as many youths interested in trying quilting with the possibility of becoming a future Guild member!

There are two age categories: youth aged 10 and under and youth aged 11 to 16.

All quilts entered will be displayed at the Quilt Show in April, **A Million Little Stitches**. Winners will be chosen by members at the March meeting. First and Second place winning ribbons will be awarded in each age category. More information will be forthcoming on how to enter. The **deadline to receive finished quilts will be March 1st, 2023** and can be dropped off to one of our executive members.
